This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in many circumstances replace the blades and carriage of a forklift, that may weigh anywhere between 100-700lbs. These buckets when set up can free up more load capacity, enabling it to handle both larger and heavier materials. The Quick-Tach is able to pour items around 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
